We remain committed to our transparent, fixed-fee processing model and to long term, stable, grower focused investments that strengthen our collective future.

Oregon Hazelnut Industry Organizations

The idea of an industry office to house different entities with overarching goals goes back to 1949. Oregon's hazelnut industry organizations evolved to meet the industry's needs and avoid duplication of efforts. These four organizations named below share one industry office and staff. Each is responsible for different projects, and each is collectively funded by growers, processors, or vendor contributions.

■ HAZELNUT MARKETING BOARD (HMB)

This organization is funded by handlers (\$10/ ton) based on their merchantable product handled. HMB is made up of (5) Growers (geographic rep); (4) Handlers and (1) Public Member. These positions are voted on by growers and handlers & appointed by the US Secretary of Agriculture.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Administer Federal Marketing Order 982
- Administer quality & volume regulations
- Oversee promotion program
- Provide industry production & use statistics

■ OREGON HAZELNUT COMMISSION (OHC)

The OHC organization is funded by growers, who are assessed (\$17/ ton) of merchantable product sold to the handler. Funds are collected by the handler and sent to OHC on behalf of the grower. OHC is made up of (6) Growers (geographic rep); (1) Handler and (1) Public Member. These positions are recommended by Nut Growers Society (NGS) & appointed by the Oregon Director of Agriculture.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Administer Oregon State Commodity Commission Act
- Administer production research with OSU & private entities
- Work with OSU Extension
- Responsible for commodity commission legislation
- Responsible for working with EPA to obtain special use chemicals

■ NUT GROWERS SOCIETY OF OREGON, WASHINGTON & BRITISH COLUMBIA (NGS)

This organization is funded by dues (\$100 Annually) and sponsorships. NGS is made up of (5) Growers (geographic rep) and (1) OSU Extension. These positions are nominated and voted on by growers.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Disseminate industry information from other organizations via the newsletter and proceedings of the annual meeting
- Hold Annual Winter Meeting and Summer Tour

■ ASSOCIATED OREGON HAZELNUT INDUSTRIES (AOHI)

This organization is funded by contracts with NGS in regard to the Winter Meeting and Summer Tour. AOHI is made up of (3) OHC Officers; (3) Largest Handlers; NGS President and (1) Person familiar with the current issue AOHI is pursuing.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Federal & State Legislative matters
- Other industry issues as needed



DID YOU KNOW?

The Nut Growers Society sponsors two meetings a year where hazelnut growers can attend workshops, tour orchards, visit with packers, and peruse trade booths for hazelnut farming-related industries and equipment manufacturers. The annual Winter Meeting takes place every January and the Summer Tour is every August at rotating locations.

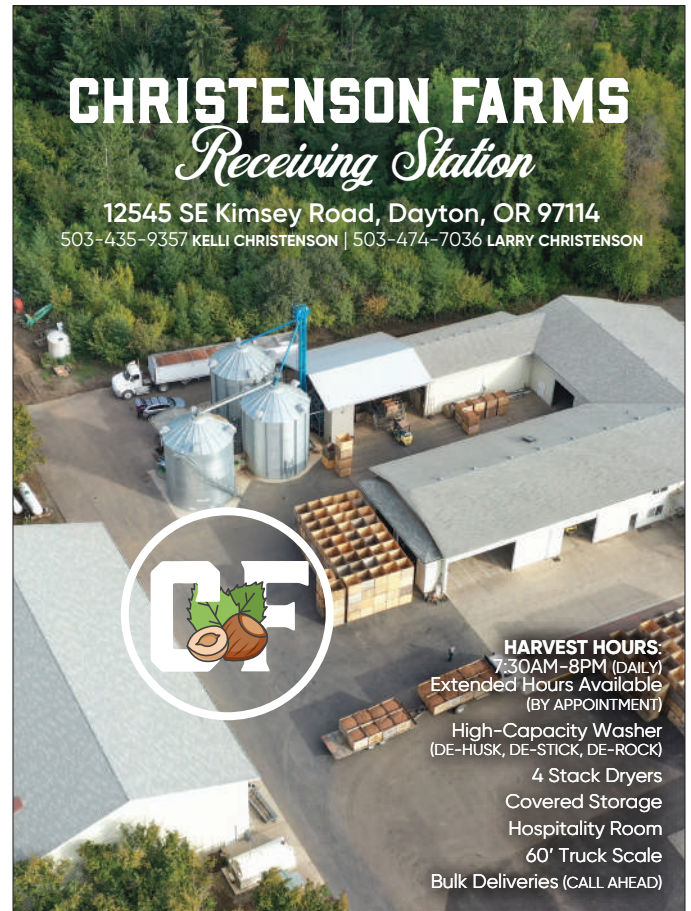
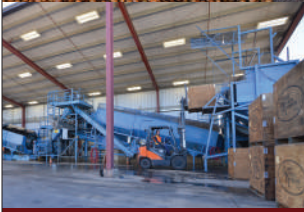

As a pro-grower contract, it sets a grower advance starting price in the fall, which member cash processors must pay growers regardless of market fluctuations. The contract supports its processors by clearly defining rules for grading, dockage, cleaning and drying, transportation, and payment terms while requiring packers to treat all their growers the same.

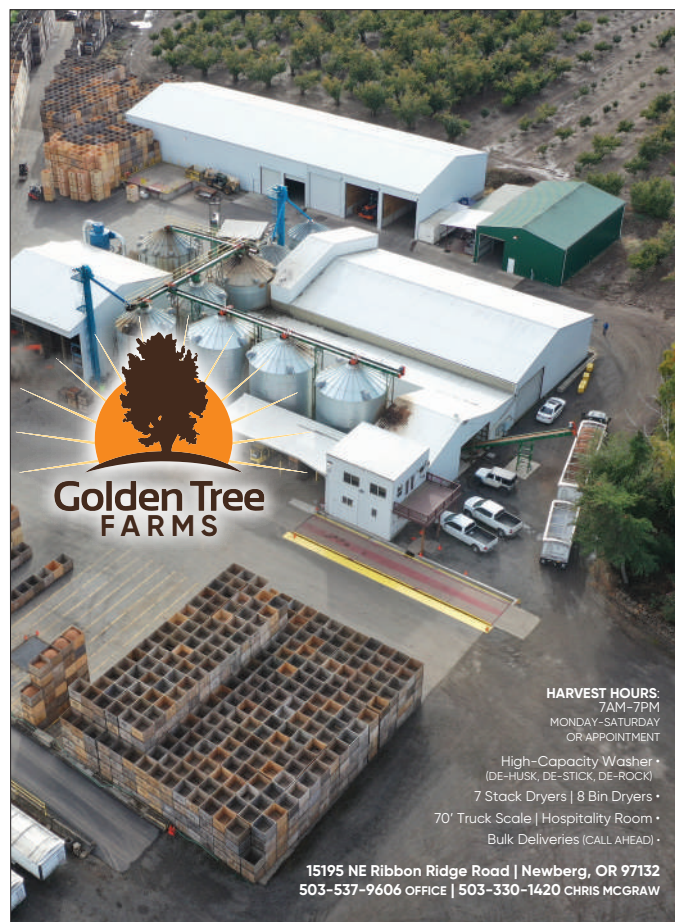

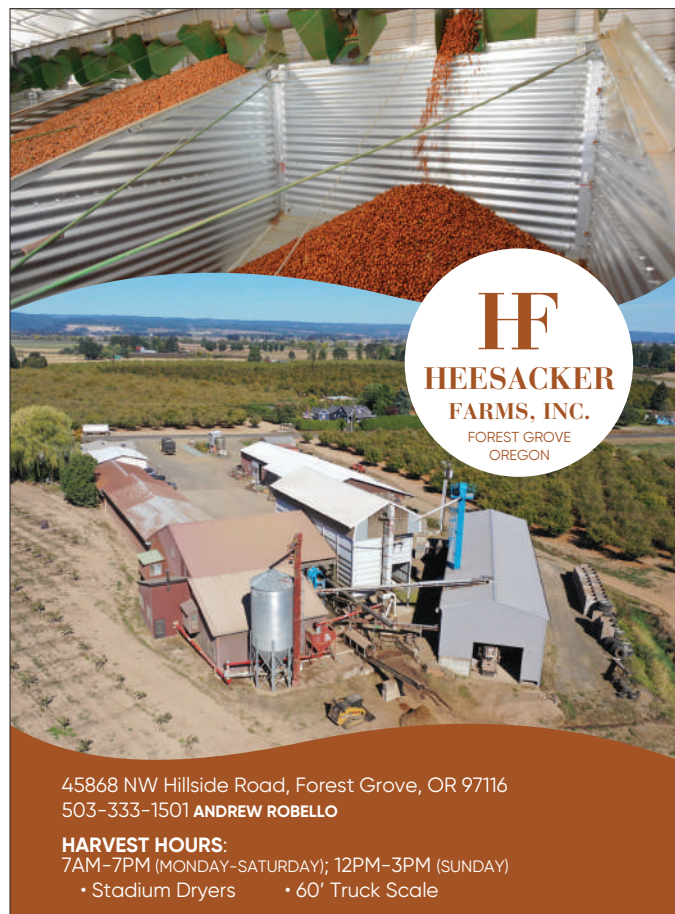

HOW TO CHOOSE

New Plantings

Before planting a new orchard, one should give serious consideration to varieties, orchard design, orchard site (soil and slope suitability), pre-plant soil management, and other factors. Some varieties are much more sensitive to Eastern Filbert Blight (EFB). See the chart below for a relative spectrum of EFB susceptibility. With new plantings, one should consider mixing in a number of pollen-compatible varieties, with suggestions at the present time leaning toward the new EFB-resistant gene pollinizer varieties released by OSU's Hazelnut Breeding Program, which are Eta, Felix, Gamma, Theta, and York. Here is a list of new varieties with the Gasaway resistance gene and their recommended pollinizers.

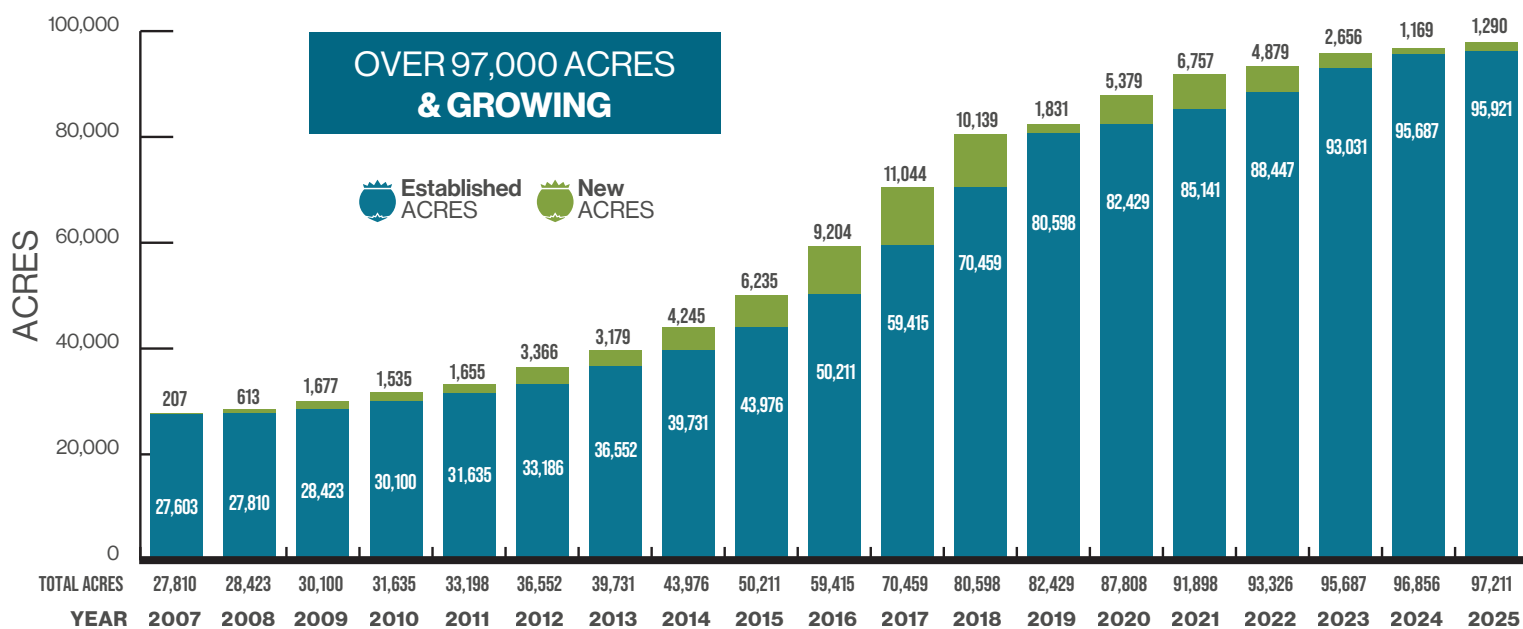

Hazelnut Production

Over 19 years, hazelnut acreage has nearly tripled to more than 97,000 acres, with 50,000–70,000 mature producing acres and about 64,000 new acres planted since 2008; planting continues but slows as some farmers switch from cane berries and grass seed to hazelnuts, while older orchards affected by Eastern Filbert Blight are being removed at roughly 500–1,000 acres per year.

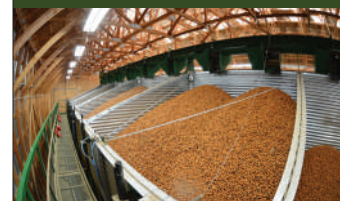

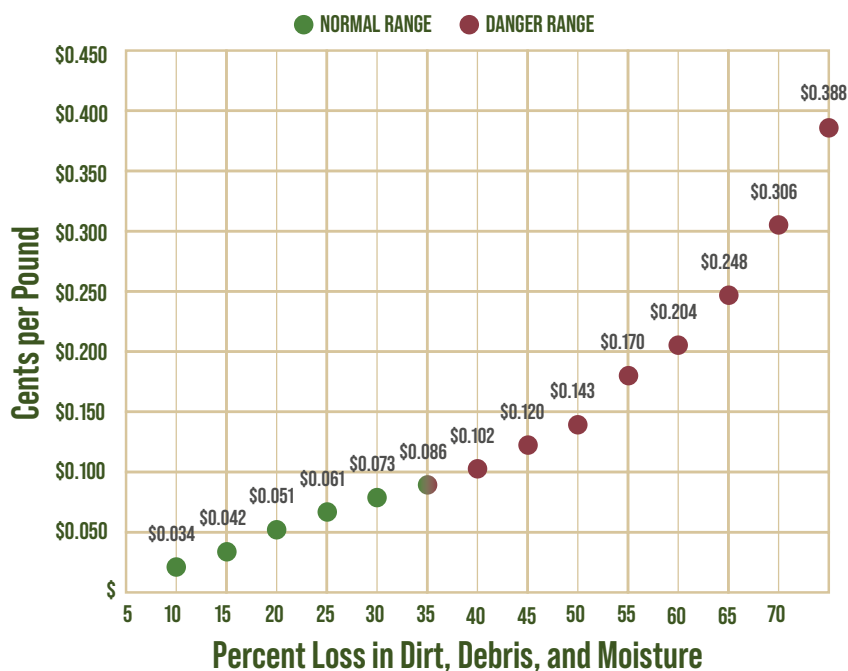

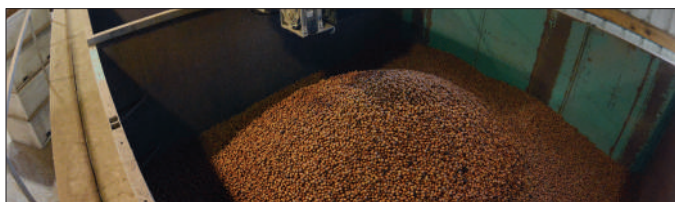
